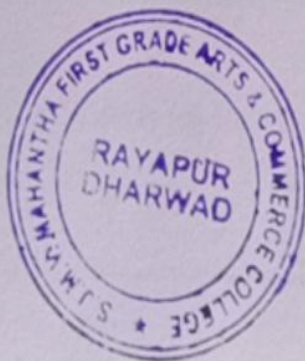


ACTION TAKEN REPORT
